How the Library is arranged:

Guide to Dewey numbers



In the Learning Centre, we use the **Dewey Decimal Classification** system to arrange our books.

The **DDC** or **Dewey** (as it is often known) is the system used by most public and academic libraries in the UK to organise their collections of books and other resources.

The DDC lists different subjects/topics and gives each of them a number. These subject numbers (also called classmarks) are the numbers we use to organise our books on the library shelves so similar topics appear together.

Always ask for help if you are stuck!

Dewey numbers used in the Learning Centre. There are many
other topics covered in the Learning Centre as well as
these.

Remember:
