Borrowing Material



- You may “borrow” (take home) a total of 12 items. This includes 8 books as well as 4 DVDs
- Books are issued to you for **3 weeks**; DVDs are issued to you for **1 week**. The date they have to come back into the Learning Centre will be stamped on the book or DVD.
- **Remember: we charge “fines” if you owe more than £1 in total** (money goes to IntoGiving, an educational charity)

Rules

The Learning Centre has some simple rules to make things fair for all:

- **You MUST have your student ID card to borrow any items from the Learning Centre - no card, no books!**
- **Remember, other people are studying - talk quietly if you are doing group work; in the Silent Study Area, NO TALKING at all**
- **Computers and printing close down 5 minutes before the end of each day**
- **DO NOT take/make calls on your mobile phone**
- **NO eating/ drinking by the Learning Centre computers – it makes the keyboards dirty & stops them working**
