A) Using Ebook Central Use your OpenAthens ID and password to access Ebsco Discovery. In Ebsco Discovery click on the red toolbar.

The first time you use it you will need to input your OpenAthens ID and username again. The next time it should go straight to Ebook Central.

B) Using Ebook Central for a specific book

Ebook Central opens with a large search box input the name of the book you are looking for e.g. Exploring British Politics and click search.

Advanced Search Browse Subjects

The book will display and give you the option to **download** or **read online**.

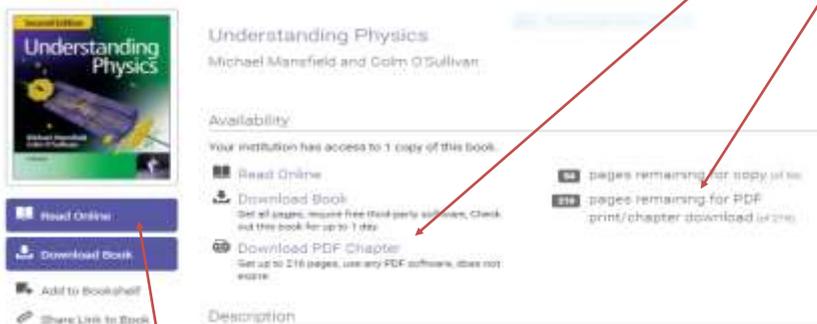
If you are using an INTO Manchester computer you can only read the book online.



If you want to download the book follow the instructions on screen you can have the book for 1-7 days. You will get a message if someone else is reading the book once they have finished you can access it.

C) Saving and Printing from Ebook Central

Click on the title of the book you are interested in e.g Understanding Physics it will tell you how many pages you can **save** or **print**.



Choose **read online** to access the print and save options.

D) Using Ebook Central to search for a subject

Firstly click on **advanced search**. Secondly a new search box appears change **contains** to **matches**. Thirdly input search e.g. molecules.



Click on **read online** and it will show where your search term appears most often by chapter. Click on the **arrow** and it tells you on which **pages** your search term appears.
